



Reviewing Respondus Monitor Videos

1. Go to the Blackboard course site that contains the exam you want to review.




a. Navigate to the “Control Panel section of the left navigation menu and click on “Course Tools.”




b. Click on “Respondus Lock-Down Browser.”

- The box on the top lists the student's name, when they took the exam, the percent of time their face was detected for analysis, how many times Respondus flagged the test, and the total flagged time.
- The bars here display in minutes the duration of the exam, the total time the facial detection was successful, the total time the student was facing the webcam, and the total time of flagged events.
- This area shows the video broken down into smaller segments. You can click on the thumbnails to view each segment.
- This is where the video plays. You can click on the play button to view the whole video or click on one of the segments in area C to view a specific part of the video.
- Right under the video the instructor can add notes and check off that they reviewed the video.
- Below instructor notes is where you can see information about the flagged segments.
